As the Fusion soccer season starts to wind down, I am asked to clarify the differences between Recreational and Academy soccer programs. I thought I would use the following table to highlight the differences between the two programs.

Fusion Recreational Soccer	Fusion Academy Program
Cost \$250 yearly.	Cost U7/8 \$600, U9/10 \$800 total for the year.
Recreational league games scheduled.	Academy games and generally one tournament.
Volunteer Coach.	Mandatory USSF or USC Licensed Coach.
Practices once or twice per week.	Practices twice per week, stressing foot skills each practice.
Uniforms provided.	Structured written format for parents to track their child's development as they progress.
	Evaluations completed for each player.
	Emphasis is placed on training and ball control.
	Uniforms and soccer ball provided.

Neither program requires try outs and you can register for either program through the [fusionsocceclub.com](http://fusionsocceclub.com) website. It is highly recommended you do so early as teams will be forming rather quickly.
